- Completed application-please do not use abbreviations.
- In a two page, single spaced, 12-point Verdana font essay, please respond to the following bullets.
  - On page one, answer the following three questions, devoting about one-third of the page to each question.
    - What have you learned about yourself while at UE? What one attribute or accomplishment sets you apart from other UE students?
    - What do you do for life balance when not studying or working? Describe how you volunteer in the community.
    - You have had many life experiences. What are two areas in which you can improve and two areas in which you excel?
  - On page two, answer the following questions, filling the entire page. Refer to the four-page biography, above, of Dr. Hartig to complete your answers. Do not repeat the information on the biography.
    - o What is your reaction to Dr. Hartig's life, achievements and legacy as provided in his biography? How do you intend to honor Dr. Hartig's life, achievements, and legacy if you were awarded this scholarship?
